We will notify you by mail either way as soon as possible once the recipients are selected. *This scholarship will not be applied prior to payment due date. Payment arrangements will need to be made by the payment due date, or the student will be dropped from enrolled courses.* 

Note that, unless otherwise specified, a dual credit scholarship may only be used for tuition and not books, fees, or other expenses incurred. In addition, the scholarship can only be awarded in the semester in which the SRC grade is awarded. If you are taking a spring semester course, or a year-long course, you are only eligible to apply for a scholarship for the spring semester for that course.
