The Student Government Association meeting was held on Wednesday, October 4, 2023, at 12:15 p.m., at the Canton Campus, Centers Building, Lower Level, Canton, Illinois.

General Functions:

Holly asked the students what other ideas for projects/events they would like to include for 2023-24. Margaret Toothaker stated she would like to host a game day. Margaret stated that she would like to have the game day to include pool, ping pong, board games, and cards. She said it would be great to get students engaged and give them a reason to hang out in the Centers area. Missy Wilkinson stated that the pickleball set has arrived, and she will work with Mike Strauman for a date that will be ready. Margaret would like to have the game day this semester, and it was suggested to do it around Halloween. Missy will also talk to Jake Douglas, eSports Coach, about the option to have the arena open for gaming that day as well.
