## General Functions:

Holly Norton called the meeting to order at 12:19 p.m.

## Approval of Minutes

Missy Wilkinson asked what games they would be interested in and the students indicated Clue, Jenga, Sriracha: The Game, Settlers of Catan, and Monopoly. Missy let the students know the pickleball court would be ready for the spring semester.

Missy Wilkinson mentioned that TRIO is sponsoring a number of events for First-Gen Week and invited the students to participate in Linn Lanes bowling on Friday, November 10, 2023.

Savannah Smith-Coulter asked that the College consider having the LRC open after the offices close at 3:30 p.m. She stated that she has talked with a number of students who would like a comfortable place to study after hours and that the LRC is the area students like to use. Savannah said that the student athletes might be able to get their study table hours done after hours if this was an option.
