Attached to this letter is an application for a dual credit scholarship through the SRC Foundation for the Fall 2024 semester. Please note that, to qualify, you'll need to complete *every* field and, if you haven't already, apply for admission to SRC. The application is due by the close of business on June 1, 2024, after which, recipients will be chosen, pending the number of applicants and the availability of funds. We will notify you by mail either way as soon as possible once the recipients are selected. We anticipate recipients will be selected by June 21, 2024.

Note that, unless otherwise specified, a dual credit scholarship may only be used for tuition and not books, fees, or other expenses incurred. In addition, the scholarship can only be awarded in the semester in which the SRC grade is awarded. If you are taking a year-long course, you are only eligible to apply for a scholarship for the spring semester for that course. However, if you are taking other courses that are fall-only, you may be considered for those as well.
