The Learning Resource Center at SRC provides academic support for all students by offering tutoring, mentoring, Canvas help, study resources, and research assistance and instruction. SRC offers professional, confidential, accessible, and brief solution-based therapy for students, free of charge, which is directed at helping students succeed in the college environment. When specialized, long-term services are needed, referrals to off-campus professionals may be made. SRC offers several free career and job placement services for students. SRC offers accommodations for qualified students with a documented disability. SRC has a Financial Aid Coordinator, located on the Canton Campus and a Financial Aid/Veterans Specialist located on the Macomb Campus. Military reservists called to active duty while enrolled at Spoon River College prior to December 1 or May 1 may withdraw from all classes and the College will offer tuition credit for a future semester or refund the money to the funding agency, depending on the source of financing. Students must provide the Dean of Student Services with a copy of their orders to request withdrawals and ensure that proper credit is given. Military reservists called to active duty while enrolled at Spoon River College after December 1 or May 1 may have completed enough of the class so that the grade could be offered. An incomplete should be offered only on the possibility of a very short tour of duty (two to three weeks). If an incomplete is offered, and the student's tour goes beyond the deadline for the incomplete to be made up (nine weeks from the end of the semester), SRC will retroactively give the student a withdrawal rather than the automatic change to an "F" grade to protect the student.
